## Birds at LCWP

About 130 species of birds have been recorded at LCWP, and of these, about 45 species are known to breed or to have bred at the site.

The pond attracts a wide variety of water birds, including grebes, ducks, herons and egrets, coots and rails, shorebirds, the belted kingfisher and an occasional gull. Several songbirds, such as red-winged blackbirds and marsh wrens, nest in the cattail marsh bordering the pond. Others, like black phoebes and violet-green swallows, nest in trees along the banks of the pond.



Scattered large cottonwoods and other trees along the cienega valley provide nest sites for red-tailed hawks, kestrels and herons.

The riparian woodlands are home in summer to Bullock's orioles, blue grosbeaks, Cassin's kingbirds, western wood-pewees, spotted and canyon towhees, black-chinned hummingbirds, and several woodpeckers. The juniper savannas on the are the breeding habitat for western meadowlarks, black-billed magpies, ash-throated flycatchers, juniper titmice, and several sparrows. Many other bird species visit LCWP in spring and fall migration, and a dozen or so species are winter visitors from farther north or from our high mountains.
