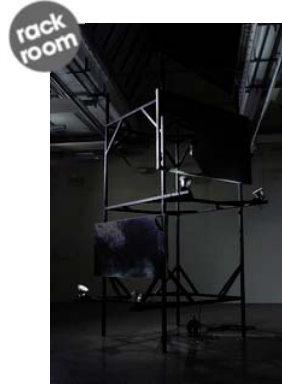

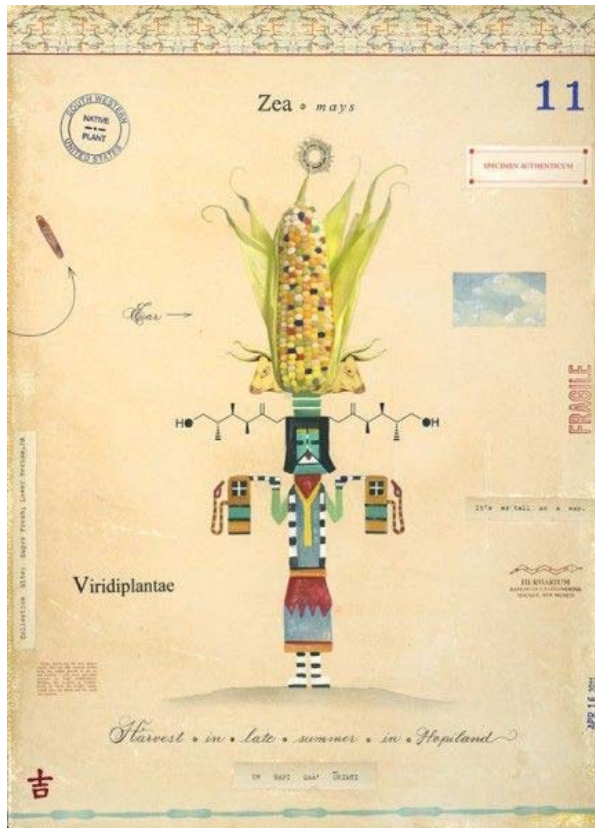

Join us for an exhibition of MF Cardamone's unique contemporary botanicals to benefit the Santa Fe Botanical Garden. Cardamone, a Pennsylvania based artist, is a graduate of the Horticulture Program at the Barnes Foundation Arboretum School in Merion, PA. This show will

consist of new work, specifically on Plants of the Southwest. While planning her Native Pennsylvanian habitat garden, she began this series, which combines the tradition of specimen mounting and botanical illustrations. Her blending of typology and narrative in each mixed media work on paper yields an intriguing visual experience that informs us about our various relationships with each plant subject.



As a result, she refers to her artwork as ethnobotanical works on paper. Cardamone has exhibited recently at The Academy of Natural Sciences in Philadelphia, at The Schuylkill Center for Environmental Education in Philadelphia and at the Winterthur Museum in Wilmington, DE. Her work intends to benefit nature conservation by engaging the public with the science, history and the beauty of plants. 50% of all proceeds will benefit the Santa Fe Botanical Garden.
